Class 1101 – Beef Heifer Commercial

Class 1101A – Beef Heifer Registered Other Breeds

Class 1101B – Beef Heifer Registered Angus

Lot 0 – Spring Calf – January 1 – April 30, 2021

Lot 1 – Fall Calf – September 1 – December 31, 2020

Lot 2 – Summer Yearling – May 1 – August 31, 2020

Lot 3 – Junior Yearling – January 1 – April 30, 2020

Lot 4 – Senior Yearling – September 1 – December 31, 2019

Class 1102 – Market Beef

Lot 1 – Steer – must have been born January 1 – August 31, 2020

Lot 2 – Heifer – must have been born January 1 – August 31, 2020

Class 1103 – Dairy Beef – Steers entered in this class can be 100% one dairy breed (Ayrshire, Brown Swiss, Guernsey, Holstein, Jersey, etc.) or NEW IN 2010 — A CROSSBRED DAIRY STEER option has been added. Crossbred Dairy Steers must be from the following breeds in any combination: Ayrshire, Brown Swiss, Guernsey, Holstein, Jersey, Milking Shorthorn, Montebeliarde, Normande, Red & White Holsteins, Norwegian Red and Viking Red (Swedish, Danish & Finnish Red) Any dairy steers crossed with beef must show as a beef steer.

Lot 1 – Steer – must have been born after January 1 – August 31, 2020

Class 1104 – Cow/Calf Commercial

Class 1104A – Cow/Calf Registered Other Breeds

Class 1104B – Cow/Calf Registered Angus

Lot 1 – Cow/Calf pairs (both the cow and the calf are exhibited) – calves must be born on or after January 1, 2021
Judging will be based on visual characteristics and performance data of the cow/calf pair.

NO animal can be exhibited in more than one animal lot.

Class 1105A – Prospect Market Calves ~ will be judged as feeder calves; performance data will not be used

Lot 1 – Steer Calf – Born January 1 – April 30, 2021 – must be castrated; bull calves are not eligible for this class

Lot 2 – Heifer Calf – Born January 1 – April 30, 2021

Class 1105B – Prospect Market Calves ~ will be judged as feeder calves; performance data will not be used, can be purebred or crossbred as stated in dairy beef class, 1103 above.

Lot 1 – Dairy Steer – Born January 1 – April 30, 2021 – must be castrated; bull calves are not eligible for this class

Class 1106 – Showmanship (Based on Age) ~ There is no fee for participation in this class.

Lot 1 – 5-11

Lot 2 – 12-16

Lot 3 – 17-21

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

First, second and third places will be awarded in each lot. Premiums will be given based on ribbons. Grand and Reserve Champion in each of the following classes will receive a plaque: 1101, 1101A, 1101B, 1102, 1103, 1104, 1104A, 1104B, 1105A and 1105B. The Grand Champion in Lots 1, 2 and 3 of Class 1106 will receive a CMCA jacket.

NOTICE: Animals may not be removed from the show grounds until after the showmanship contest is completed or you will be forfeiting any awards. Premiums must be picked up after the show; no premiums will be mailed out.

22nd Annual Aitkin County Youth Beef Show

The Aitkin Beef Show will be Saturday, July 10 at 10 a.m. at the Aitkin County Fairgrounds. This is a wonderful one-day show for beef exhibitors to attend. Classes include all ages of commercial and registered heifers, steers, cow/calf pairs and prospect calves as well as showmanship for all ages. Age requirements for animals are the same as Minnesota State Fair guidelines. This year exhibitors can be 5-21 years of age since this is a CMCA sponsored event.

The show is sponsored by the Central Minnesota Cattlemen's Association. Plaques, CMCA jackets, ribbons and premiums are given out.

NOTICE: Animals may not be removed from the show grounds until after the showmanship contest is completed or you will be forfeiting any awards. Premiums must be picked up after the show; no premiums will be mailed out.

Registration information is included with this letter. **PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED.** Please mail with entry fee to: Sharon Dotzler, 38814 455th Place, Aitkin, MN 56431 by June 25. Everyone who registers by JUNE 25 will receive a free t-shirt. So, don't delay, get your registration in today.

Cattle may begin to stall after 7 p.m. on Friday, July 9. Bedding (shavings) will be provided. Exhibitors must bring their own feed and equipment. Original registration papers must be presented for registered cattle. No animal can be exhibited in more than one animal lot. If an exhibitor needs assistance in the ring or needs more than one animal returned to the ring for championship honors, another youth must exhibit the animal, no parents are allowed to exhibit. In the case of safety concerns, a ring steward will assist the youth.

- Vehicles with trailers should use the trailer entrance. From the fairground entrance it is east on County Road 54. There will be signs.

All cattle must be officially identified for exhibition, Veterinarians will be checking and ID should be applied at home, not at the show. BAH identification rules will be strictly enforced.
